Loudoun County Man Sentenced to 60 Months For Distribution of Child Pornography

(Alexandria, Virginia) – Matthew King, age 38, of Round Hill, Virginia, was sentenced today to 60 months in prison. King pled guilty on April 14, 2008 to distribution of child pornography. Chuck Rosenberg, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia, and Mark X. McGraw, Acting Special Agent in Charge, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), made the announcement after sentencing by United States District Judge Leonie M. Brinkema.

Upon his release from incarceration, King will remain under Court supervision for a term of 10 years. King also will be required to register as a sex offender in any jurisdiction in which he lives, works, or goes to school.

According to court documents, law enforcement agents conducted a search of King's residence and found more than 1,000 images and 80 movies containing depictions of child pornography on King's home computer. In addition, King used his AOL account to distribute images of child pornography to others while using screen names like "BadSarah13" and "LitlHeather14."

This case was investigated by ICE. Assistant United States Attorney John Eisinger prosecuted the case on behalf of the United States.
